






Total Grants by Program Area





The Power of Collective Philanthropy

Each year, WPN members pool their annual dues and award a high-impact grant to a nonprofit focused on improving school readiness and student achievement. As an advised fund at CFNLA, 80% of annual dues are granted in the donation year while 20% are invested in the WPN Endowment Fund for future grants. The endowment, currently valued at **over \$580,000**, ensures future grant availability and builds a lasting legacy for the WPN.

Volunteers for Youth Justice: The Harbor

The WPN awarded **\$90,000** to Volunteers for Youth Justice (VYJ) to support The Harbor, VYJ's new comprehensive community-based resource center. The Harbor is a collaborative effort with Caddo Parish School Board and Caddo Parish Juvenile Court to address the needs of families in crisis. The Harbor houses various programs under one roof. This allows families and children convenient access to services such as: mental health counseling; physical, occupational, and speech therapies; basic needs assistance; truancy services; domestic violence and child abuse advocacy; workforce development; and more.



The WPN has awarded over \$1.4 million to educational initiatives in our community since its inception in 2005.


Investments



Several money management firms manage the Foundation's long-term pool portfolio, each having a specific role in the overall management process. These firms were chosen following a rigorous selection process conducted by the Foundation's Board of Directors and Investment Committee. The Foundation's investment consulting firm, Fund Evaluation Group, assists the Foundation's Board and Investment Committee in all asset manager selection and performance management issues for its long-term pool.

In 2023, the long-term pool produced an 11.6% return against a policy index of 12.8%, net of all management fees. From September 1997 through December 2023, the long-term pool portfolio averaged 6.9% against a policy index of 6.4%.

To award grants from unrestricted funds, CFNLA evaluates applications based on their responsiveness to community need, whether the program is effective and able to track outcomes, and the financial soundness of the applicant organization. Unrestricted funds may also be used to support special initiatives addressing specific community challenges.
